Please note that the daycare will be closed on the ped day scheduled for Friday, November 25, 2016.



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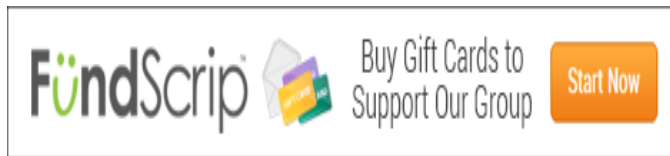
MESSAGE FROM MRS. BIGLAND
